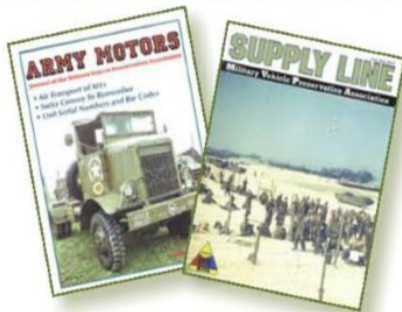

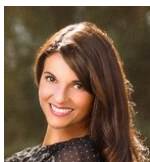

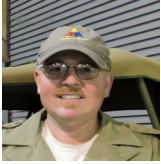

Also gave a membership form to a gentleman (Aubrey King) who has a 1944 jeep and is interested in joining. He had a nice Corvette in the parade this year.

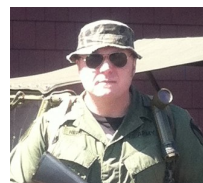
