Convention Hotel Room Block Filling Up

As of May 6, both the Tuesday and Wednesday night room blocks for our \$119 convention rate (plus tax) at the Doubletree Hotel in Pleasanton have been consumed. Time to get your reservations in for Thursday-Sunday! The link to our customized reservation page is on the MVPA and our websites. If you phone the hotel or use the general Hilton reservation system, use the Group Code MVC to get the special rate. Do not select days including Tuesday or Wednesday because it will say "no rate available."

When the Tuesday nights were used up we negotiated for 10 rooms for \$189 rate. Regular August rate for a Tuesday is well over \$220! These rooms might still be available so if you want one, contact our rep Tiffany Choi at 925-737-5607 now. But this deal does not include Wednesday.ted a special rate of \$129 for the prior Friday-Monday. Plug in any or all of those days and you will see it.

We previously mentioned a rate of \$129 having been set for us for the Friday-Monday before the show. As of this writing the hotel is saying it was a "courtesy" and not a "contract" and we are going to learn if they will guarantee it. If you are interested to come in that early, check with John Neuenburg at 415-847-2801 or try to make that reservation using code MVC and selecting Friday-Monday dates only.



It was brought to my attention that many people in the south believe it is farther to Pleasanton than Lodi? On the map above are two black arrows one pointing to Lodi or more specific Tower park out on Highway 12. The other arrow is pointing at approximately where the Fairgrounds in Pleasanton are. If you look in the Pacific Ocean, there is a compass showing north.

Not sure but it sure looks like if you were to draw a line east to west along Highway 12 and another east to west just below Highway 580 near Pleasanton and look at the mileage scale, Lodi is a farther North on Highway 5. Not only that but anyone who travels between Tracey and Lodi will tell you the roads are in disrepair and always under construction. The junction to 580 East off of 5 North moves and it is a quick trip over the hill to Pleasanton. So look at this map and put out the word "ALL Roads Lead To Pleasanton" and the 2016 MVPA Convention. Bring your MV, all sizes, shapes and condition we have the room.


