GENERAL INFORMATION

It's a MV gathering AND a swap meet! Clear out your shed! Sell the stuff you bought in April so you can buy more stuff! No charge to sell from your campsite. No vending in other places.

We are focused in Campground 2 this time, the one by the main levee road, NOT CG 4 where we used to be in the Fall. This puts us close to Rosa's Restaurant, bar, store, Sunset Sweets, and the marina and boat ramp.

Early birds welcome prior to Tuesday. Last Sunday is pull out day, not a show day

Day visitor fee for our commuters is waived. See parking section below.

Hotels are six miles east by Interstate 5. More lodging at B&W Resort, 5 miles west on Hwy 12.

There will be a fee and wristband to use the pools in Campground 4. Ask at office.

As usual, no fires on the ground because the peat soil will burn underground. Raised pits and wood are available.

If you are using a campsite you have used in the past, be aware they have installed paved patios and fire pits in some that can affect where you park or position a tent.

To make a <u>camping or cabin reservation</u>, contact our "Wagonmistress" Jo-Ann Lesser at mamalesser@yahoo.com or 408-238-8277. She will assign you a site and will tell the reservation office to accept your deposit for it.

If you are bringing a MV but are not renting a campsite and have no place to park, usually someone has extra space in their site they will trade for beer, soda, or cash! Ask around or ask a MVCC officer, or contact John Neuenburg at in garage@hotmail.com or 415-847-2801 or at space #148. Same goes if you have a site with extra room for a MV. John will try to put people together. To share a site for camping, Jo-Ann might know of someone.

PARKING

No parking in the campgrounds unless in <u>your</u> campsite. That includes along the roads in camp. Commuters use the levee which is very close, and walk in via stairs or ramp. Park on the campground side, not in front of the tenant boat sheds. No parking fee.

<u>DO NOT STORE TRAILERS ON THE LEVEE!</u> They use up space. Use the lot by the guard shack or frontage road shoulder.

Roads are fire lanes – do not block them. Do not park in a vacant campsite because it won't be vacant for long!

Management may have illegally parked vehicles towed to Lodi or Stockton


