Hello Everyone:

Well it's here, the last newsletter of 2017. 2017 is a year that will go down in MVCC history. Besides being the 40th Anniversary of the founding of our club, it was a year that saw many changes.

After Tower Park KOA was purchased by Jellystone Park, the MVCC was forced to move the Spring meet to another venue. After an extensive search, Camp Petaluma, also a KOA, has filled that need. We had our first meet there in April and while there were some bugs, the MVCC board is working, even as I write this, behind the scenes to try and mitigate as many of these problems as possible in preparation for the second annual swapmeet there.

The annual fall swapmeet was held as usual after several meetings with the Jelly Stone management team to work out the bugs at Camp Delta, Jellystone Park. The fall event will remain at Camp Delta for the foreseeable future.

The club now has a quartermaster's trailer (mobile PX) and the club's inventory is being updated with new items. A link to these items was placed on the MVCC web page. Stop by the webpage and check it out. I spoke with Woody at Camp Petaluma KOA and there is quite a bit of campsite changes going on. Please try to double up on these sites as many are 70-foot-long. That is twice as much room as most sites at Tower Park. The more people with camping sites reserved in the park, the less we have to worry about day use parking if the fields are muddy. If you are coming just for the day, plan for offsite parking. Remember if you double up with a friend the fee is reduced. Its \$10 a night per person to camp in the group tent area. This is another good plan to get inside if coming for just a night or two. There are opportunities to camp in a GP medium tent as well, but you need to talk to Greg Lalonde and see how much room is available and what you need to bring such as a cot. Also remember that there are guest wrist bands available. You need to tell the office who your guests are when you check in. The wrist bands are made by the park staff and kept in the office at the registration desk, so your quests can pick them up when they check in.

Stay tuned to the newsletter for changes as we put more info out about the spring swapmeet.
