SPRING SWAPMEET NEWS

PETALUMA HERE WE COME

Listed below is some useful info about the April 18-23, 2017, Swap Meet move to Petaluma KOA. I will try and answer some questions and give you some useful info in this short article.

As you probably already know, Tower Park was sold to Jellystone Park Camp-Resort, and because of the changes Jellystone has planned for that park, we are moving the Swap Meet in April 2017, to Petaluma KOA. An exhaustive search was conducted for a new park that would meet the various needs of MVCC members. Petaluma KOA had many of the attributes we have enjoyed at Tower Park plus a couple added benefits. This is an MVCC Swap Meet and is open to all. MVCC members get first choice of campsites. Guests and visitors are welcome. There is a four night minimum stay. This was instituted during negotiations with KOA to bring down the rates and to help secure the campground, so that the MVCC would have exclusive use for as many days as possible. The four nights will be anytime Tuesday thru Saturday. You will still be able to come in early and stay later if you would like to. Also KOA has promised not to double rent a paid spot if a camper pulls out early.

JoAnn lesser is acting as our Wagon Master and all reservations and cancelations need to be made and tracked by Joann. She is the MVCC's primary contact with KOA. Joann's phone number is 408-238-8277. Joann is working very hard at this time to accommodate everyone who would have had a reservation for the

2017 Spring Swap Meet at Tower Park. You cannot get a campsite for our event by calling KOA or going to their website.

As of today, you can call Petaluma KOA and pay to reserve your site. Joann has sent a list to KOA with all the reserved site info, and it has been put into the KOA reservation system. It is now up to you the member to get a deposit on your site by calling the KOA in Petaluma. If you are not in their system, please call Joann. The phone number for Petaluma KOA is 707-763-1492. The address is 20 Rainsville Road, Petaluma CA. 94952. The official dates for the MVCC Spring Swap Meet are April 18-23, 2017. The KOA website is http://koa.com/campgrounds/san-francisco/

There are various types of campsites and costs for them ranging from 65 foot long full pull throughs at \$50 a night for single use and \$37.50 a night for double use. Also developed sites that are tent or vehicle dry camping for \$37.50 a night as well as dry tent only camping in three group areas at \$10 a head a night. The 6 person Deluxe Lodges are \$140 a night and the studio lodges are \$130 a night. There are a number of 1 room camping cabins without bathrooms that are \$57 a night. These have a TV and low wattage power. Take notice that if you share a pull through, you can put two small motor homes or a motor home and a tent and share the hookups for \$37.50 a night each. The park has a truck to service your dump tanks at your campsite if you are in a site that has water and power but no sewer. They will pump your tanks twice during the week for free. You do not have to be there. They will give you two stickers for your windshield. Make sure to ask for them when you check in. There is onsite propane and a dump station.

Down in the tent camping area, there is a camp kitchen with sinks and counters to wash dishes and prepare food. There are freshly remodeled restrooms with showers throughout the park. Amenities include a large pool, hot tub, and store in the office with firewood for the fire pits in the campsites. When you check-in you will be given a wristband for everyone in your party present up to four depending on your site type of course. If you have guests arriving later, they can pick theirs up when they check-in at the KOA desk. Everyone must check in and wear their wristband. If you tow a vehicle on a trailer, we are working on nearby parking for trailers so stayed tuned for that info.

Sonoma county and the north coast is an area that has many outdoor activities. There are many lazy roads to travel to local attractions that are either day or half-day trips. Some attractions are a mile away in downtown Petaluma, and some are 20 miles away at the coast or nearby wine country. As we get closer, there will be more info about food during the day, dinners and activities.




Figure 3—Left Front Three-quarter View of Tractor Truck M26 (Windows Open)



We attended three events for Veterans Day: On November 10th, a presentation and display at the El Dorado Hills Senior Center featuring Nancy Porter giving a talk on WWII sites you can visit in Hawaii, Vanuatu, Solomon Islands, and other islands in the South Pacific. I displayed a '43 GTB cargo truck and my '45 Willys Holden style ambulance jeep, both appropriately USMC vehicles for the Marine Corps birthday that day. The vehicles drew a large crowd including a couple of appreciative Marine Corps vets. On November 11th, the annual Veterans Day Parade in Auburn. We had 10 jeeps and a Halftrack in attendance, organized by Ben Hovis and the Foothill Vintage Jeep Group. I transported Barney Gruber, a locally popular Marine Corps vet that fought on Iwo Jima in WWII. On November 12th, a display hosted by the Northern Recon Group included free rides for veterans and veteran's family members on an authentic, operational "Higgins boat" LCVP landing craft, the same one that was on display at the MVPA Convention in Pleasanton. I was able to drive my '43 GPW onto the landing craft and go for a short cruise in Ellis Lake in Marysville, followed by a driving the jeep down the ramp and out onto the shore in a dramatic "landing", splashing through 6" of water onto the boat ramp. What a kick.

Upcoming events are winding down for 2016, with a few Christmas parties to attend being about the only thing left for this year. In early December we'll be flying with a small group of military vehicle collectors to Oahu for the 75th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor. We'll be visiting WWII sites, watching the parade in Honolulu, and going on the last "Home of the Brave" tour. The tour includes visits to the USS Arizona memorial, the USS Missouri, the Museum of the Pacific on Ford Island, Wheeler Field and other sites with an emphasis on December 7, 1941.
