

From Dave's Motor Pool...

I have had some calls and there is still some confusion about the move next April 18-23, 2017, to Petaluma KOA. One of the things I am hearing is "should I get my reservation money back from Jellystone formally known as Tower Park," and the answer is yes, absolutely. Call Cathy at Tower (209) 369-1041 and ask for a full refund for April and September. Another question I am hearing, "is the MVCC still having the Annual Fall Swapmeet at Tower Park in September?" The answer is that as of today, October 28, we do not know if that will be possible. The second part to that answer is that at the MVCC Board meeting this past September, your MVCC Board discussed this with Jellystone management and as of today, they do not have an updated site map that reflects the park layout after the planned changes are made, which would make it very hard to make reservations. Another point made was because of the water park and other changes to Camp Ground Four, the MVCC would probably use Camp Ground One, Two and Three as our area of operation. The MVCC has left the door open on returning to Tower next September, and I have had recent conversations with Jellystone and made sure that the door will be open for us to return if possible.

Petaluma April 2017 is a for real thing, and as I type this, Danny at the KOA front desk and Joann Lesser have started inputting our members' names and site reservation info into the KOA system.

This is a painstaking amount of work that includes a lot of phone time with members to qualify their needs. There are several types of spaces and costs for each of those as well as discounts if the space is doubled up on. Each person will be allowed a number of wristbands that go with the site they reserve.

You will be required to put names on those wristbands when you sign in. If those quests are not with you at check in, they will need to go to the office when they arrive and check in and pick up the wrist band that has their name on it. There will be day-use wristbands as well and a charge for that. The reason I am explaining this is because there have been questions about this being a MVCC members only swapmeet. The MVCC has grown to be a very large group of friends, and we need a very large space to have fun.

One of the largest issues we will always have is finding that space. In the past, we have had members on wait list for sites and non-members with sites. This has been an issue for some time now and causes some head butting in the front office. The MVCC events are always open to everyone. We will try to fit everyone in, even if a space is just a piece of ground for a tent. That said parking will always be the choke point. We are giving out sites to members first. This is the right thing to do.

Check the address label on the newsletter envelope to verify your membership expiration date. If there is room after that, the MVCC will try to fit everyone else in. If you have any questions, the door is always open to anyone with an interest in the MVCC and/or military vehicles.



The Foothills Vintage Jeep Group honored United States Army WW2 Veteran Gene Goodin in this year's Lincoln 4th of July 2016 Parade.

Gene Goodin received special recognition from US Congressman, Doug LaMalfa and Jim Nielsen, CA State Assemblyman for honorable service to our nation.

Staff Sergeant US Army Gene Goodin Volunteered for 101st Airborne and assigned to 501st Headquarters Div. under Maj. Butler. His division jumped on D-Day, June 1944, at St. Mere Eglise, and at Nijmegen during Market Garden. They were transported by truck to Bastogne on December 20 (they *jumped* off the back of trucks there) where they were surrounded for 26 days. Final jump was into Germany at the Rhine to hold the bridges. Each jump, the 501st lost 50% of their men in battle.




