## WAGON MISTRESS UPDATED INFORMATION



Tower Park is wrapping up renovations, they have asked the MVCC to wait on reservations for our April 2019 Camp Delta meet. Reservations for current MVCC members will be open October 1, 2018 and everyone else on November 1, 2018. This meet will be a 4-day minimum event however, early birds are always welcome. The MVCC will have campgrounds 2, 3, and 4 same as in years past. We will not have new campground 1 (sites 1 thru 84). As we are starting over with this meet, all reservations will go thru the Tower Park reservation system 209.369.1041. After this year, reservations will go through me JoAnn.

Go to www.towerparkresort.com and check out the current campground map. Choose a site that will best accommodate you. Some sites are no longer back-to-back sites and are now 70' pull through's. We will be tight on spaces as we've lost about 50 sites to cabins and redesigned sites. Sharing of sites is encouraged however, Tower Park will not split the bill. This will need to be worked out on your own. If you will be needing a dry tent site you will need to contact me directly 408.238.8277.

At the time you make your reservation you will be asked to place a deposit of 50% of the cost of your stay. The remaining balance will be due at time of check-in. Anyone looking for a tent site will need to confirm with Tower Park that the site chosen will accommodate tent stakes. Rates for sites was published in issue 4 of the MVCCNEWS.





#### AFTER ACTION REPORT: EAGLE FIELD DINNER DANCE FLY-IN

This was our first time at Eagle Field and it certainly won't be the last! Other commitments in years past have kept us away but with Erik's retirement, a new motor home and a borrowed trailer to haul our '42 Willys, we were able to make the journey to this isolated airfield. Built in 1942 to train pilots for WWII, it's holding on due to the hard work and commitment of its owner, Joe Davis, and many, many volunteers. On Saturday, we watched the arrival of vintage aircraft including WWII war birds, observation planes, passenger planes and a trainer. Military vehicles were driving around and the day ended with an excellent dinner and dance complete with a swing band. Lots of guests were dressed in period clothing and uniforms giving the event a very authentic look and feel of what it must have been like back in the early 1940s.

Saturday also included an military vehicle scavenger hunt, organized by Don Gomes and Johnny Verissimo, where the vehicle crews drove around the base looking for clues to crack a "top secret" code. We had 3 excited kids in our Jeep helping us search. After gathering all the clues, they enlisted the help of their grandfather (whose father had trained at Eagle Field) and were eventually able to crack the code.

This is why we love this "hobby" of ours. Yes there were planes and military vehicles but more importantly, there were people. Families impacted by our military who want their children and grandchildren to know and appreciate this history. The kids manned our .30 caliber, wore helmets and listened to stories, They were very happy to receive MVCC patches for cracking the code (thank you Don Gomes) and I am certain that they will want to someday own a military vehicle of their own someday. The kids were more than happy to go back out on Sunday to pick up all the code papers from around the base.

Eagle Field is already on our calendar for June of 2019. We will be back with our Jeep and look forward to seeing all those new friends to share more history, knowledge and camaraderie.






