Time to put away your holiday decorations and get ready for Camp Plymouth at the 49'er RV Resort and the Amador County Fairgrounds. The MVCC has been charged by the RV resort and the Fairgrounds to now take all registrations and payment. If you attended in September 2019, this is how reservations were handled. It's a new way of doing things and might be a bit confusing. Hopefully I can help with any questions that might arise. You will find in this issue the registration form and a page or two titled "Operational Orders." The form is simple enough to fill out. If you attended the April 2019 event, you should use that space number when filling out the form. If you've forgotten your space number, no worries I have that information. Returning attendees registrations form will be accepted starting January 1, 2020. New attendees registration forms will be accepted and filled starting February 1, 2020. New attendees please mark "new" on the space# line on the registration form. I will assign you a site when I receive your registration and will follow up with you. If you have spoken or e-mailed me regarding a site move, I will do my best to accommodate your request after all returning members registration forms have been received.

A few things to keep in mind. Registration forms will be accepted and processed as they arrive and sites will be filled first by those that attended in 2019. New registrations will be filled after returning members registration forms have been received.

The deadline for all registrations will be March 15, 2020. Do not procrastinate in returning your forms and payment. The MVCC has deadlines to meet with the RV Resort and the Fairgrounds and may not be able to hold sites indefinitely. Any sites not registered for after March 15 will be

considered open and available.

Cancellations with full refund must be received by March 30,2020.

Cancellations after April 1, 2020, will be considered on a one-on-one basis with possible loss of payment.

No refunds will be issued during the event.

### Happy holidays MV friends,

The rains are finally upon us and it's a bit chilly out there. The holidays are also right around the corner so the wife and I took the opportunity to give thanks to our fallen military by participating in Wreaths Across America by placing wreaths at the Sacramento National Cemetery in Dixon CA, on Saturday December 14th. Luckily the weather was good and we didn't have to dress for rain. Tons of people participate in this annual event. We've done this event before, and as crowded as it gets, it isn't a great place to bring a big MV although I bet a few jeeps, humvees, M37s would be a big hit. Maybe we can get a few to participate next year. We also participate in the wreath removal. It's scheduled for Saturday January 11th at 7:30am. I brought the M35A2 last year. It was a tight squeeze getting around all the cars but was well worth it. That truck can hold a lot of wreaths. Please reach out to me if you want to join us for the cleanup. Last month I mentioned tackling the halftrack project and sharing the progress. Well, I have made some progress but got side tracked on a couple other projects so I'll share halftrack progress next month. Instead, I buckled down and finished painting the welding tanks for the wrecker. They are display only but did come off an actual military wrecker. They are a unique size so it took me a bit to find them. I ended up finding them in Georgia. I got lucky and someone I knew was driving thru there heading West so they got a free ride to California. I also needed to replace the CUCV fan, water pump, brake and alternator's belts. I used the M1008 truck the other day and lost all the belts at once. It was challenging to drive with no power steering and no brakes! Anyway, apparently there is quite a bit of discussion in regards to the size of the replacement belts. I ended buying the three belts (shown in the picture). They were a tight fit. To install, get them over and past the crank pulley first. Then put them on the pulley of either alternator or the power steering pump. Using a 1/2" socket, rotate the motor crank and feed on each belt. This process worked great and the belts are a nice tight fit. Tons of adjustment left for belt stretching and no squealing. I also got around to making a gun ring adapter plate for a German MG3 gun ring but I'm saving that discussion for next month along with halftrack progress. 






M3 Half-Track mounted with two 3-tube rocket launchers at the Bengal Air Depot near Calcutta (now Kolkata), India, 1942-45.



### OPERATIONAL ORDERS - as of Dec 2019

(Previously known as Basic Training)

This is a new location for the largest annual Military Vehicle swap meet and gathering on the West Coast. The new venue is located at the 49 Village RV Resort and adjacent Amador County Fairgrounds in the Historic California Foothill Gold Country at Plymouth, Amador County.

OP ORDER 14-19.4.20: MVCC Bivouac Rules and Regulations for the Spring 2020 Event

### **CAMPING**

- 1. Official event dates are Tuesday, 14 April thru Sunday, 19 April, 2020. Group discount rates at the 49er are valid 3 days before and 3 days after the event on a space available basis.
- 2. Cabins and RV camping only at the 49er, no tent camping allowed.
- 3. Tent camping at the Fairgrounds, no large RVs (unless there is no space at the 49er).
- 4. Tent camping at the Fairgrounds is mostly dry camping. A limited number of sites with water and power are available, but are already reserved as of this writing.
- 5. 4 night minimum reservation at the 49er for RV camping.
- 6. No minimum reservation for tent camping at the Fairgrounds. Full payment for camping at the Fairgrounds is required at time of reservation.
- 7. All reservations for RV and tent campsites will be booked and coordinated through the MVCC Camp Mistress (JoAnn Lesser) at mvcccampmistress@yahoo.com.
- 8. Campfires are permitted in above-ground fire pits at the 49er and at the Fairgrounds.
- 9. The 49er and the Fairgrounds are pet friendly. Dogs must be kept on a leash in public areas.
- 10. Discharge of firearms is prohibited at the 49er and the Fairgrounds.

### DAY USE AND PARKING

- 11. No MV registration is required. Bring 'em all.
- 12. Free visitor parking at the Fairgrounds. No long term visitor parking within the 49er Resort.
- 13. Vehicle access is through the front gate at the 49er and the Empire Street gate at the Fairgrounds.
- 14. Free trailer and tow rig parking at the Fairgrounds.
- 15. No admission charge to attend the meet. No wrist bands required.
- 16. No vehicle parking on lawn areas due to the presence of underground sprinkler systems.
- 17. Roads in the 49er and the Fairgrounds shall not be blocked by parked vehicles at any time.

### **SWAP MEET and DISPLAYS**

- 18. No fee for buying or selling at your campsite, except for campsite rental.
- 19. Swap meet is event-wide at the 49er and Fairgrounds campsites.
- 20. Vendors must rent an RV or tent campsite to sell merchandise.
- 21. Open House with the local public invited will be held on Friday, 17 April from 1000 to 1700 hours. Meet participants are encouraged to be present during Open House hours. Period dress, military uniforms and vehicle displays are encouraged.
- 22. Free vehicle and foot traffic access to the 49er and Fairgrounds to view displays and participate in the Swap Meet is permitted.
- 23. Foot traffic access is available through a gate between the Fairgrounds and the 49er. Gate is located between 49er campsites 23 and 25, and the southeast corner of the Fairgrounds Arena.
- 24. Tracked vehicles with steel grousers may not be driven on paved areas within the 49er or Fairgrounds campgrounds.
- 25. Military-themed displays are allowed and encouraged at campsites in both campgrounds.
- 26. Special Displays can be accommodated free of charge in the Fairgrounds, outside designated campsites.
- 27. Normal campsite rental fee is required for Special Displays not in a campsite if also used for overnight accommodation (sleeping overnight within the display).

### **AMENITIES**


- 28. Amenities at the 49er include: Pool, hot tub, volleyball, shuffleboard, horseshoes, billiards, kids playground, Rec Hall with kitchen, Amphitheatre, Terrace, Café, restrooms with showers, laundry, store, propane, limited temporary parking.
- 29. Amenities at the Fairgrounds include: restroom with showers, unlimited parking (except on fire access roads within the tent camping area), limited water and power.
- 30. Hotels, restaurants, grocery store, antique stores, hardware store, Indian Casino, Wineries, Historic Gold Rush towns and sites and other attractions are within a short distance of the campgrounds.




